

JdeMO Operating Tips and Practices for Rav4 EV

Thank you for purchasing the singular best modification for the Rav4 EV since its inception. What follows are tips and practices that may aid you in the use and enjoyment of your new equipment.

A. Because the 12 volt battery is disconnected on your Rav4 EV during the installation of your JdeMO assembly, the first thing that you'll want to check on your car is the following:

- 1) While the stored (preset) radio and SiriusXM stations will remain, your last station listened to will likely be changed.
- 2) If you had "random play modes" selected, it will change.
- 3) Your cell / mobile phone Bluetooth[™] pairings may have changed. We recommend deleting both your phone from the car and also the car from your phone, and then reconnecting.
- 4) Almost everything on the navigation map display may have changed.
- 5) The default U.S. state selection from the destination address page will disappear.
- 6) The volume of navigation voice notifications may be changed.
- 7) The charge schedule will be retained, but it won't work without hitting the "SAVE" button again (on the previous screen from the actual schedule).
- 8) The air conditioner will be turned off, regardless of previous setting.

B. While charging the car with JdeMO, you may wish to leave the car and need to lock it. First, you need to remove the mechanical key from the FOB, by pressing the small button on the side that says "PRESS" and easily slide out the mechanical key by pulling it while continuing to hold the PRESS button down. This will take two hands! Then, you can lock the car while charging (while it is in "READY" mode) by using the mechanical key on the driver's door only.

While not required, we also recommend turning the headlights and Daytime Running Lights (DRL) to OFF. Finally, you can run down the driver's instrument lights with the dash mounted switch on the left side of the steering wheel, and turn off the center navigation screen by holding the lower main button for 3 seconds. The purpose is for these practices may be so that others won't think that you left your car running and unattended.

C. There are a multitude of charging units, networks, fobs, cards, etc, out on the road for you to use. Which ones to know about will depend on your location, and where you plan to travel.

D. JdeMO has several modes that are manipulated by the green LED switch under the hood. Please follow the directions on the placard mounted under the hood.
